

***“I pray that from His glorious, unlimited resources He will give you mighty inner strength through His Holy Spirit. And I pray that Christ will be more and more at home in your hearts as you trust in Him. May your roots go down deep into the soil of God’s marvelous love.”
Ephesians 3:16, 17 (NLT)***

Inner healing is the healing of our inner man, which we refer to as our ‘soul’. Our soul consists of our mind, our will and our emotions. Inner healing is sometimes called emotional healing, or healing of memories, or soul healing.

Therefore, inner healing is healing of the mind, will and emotions. We have learned that euphoric recall tempts us to return to our addiction because it allows us to remember only the good things about our experience with chemicals. Even though euphoric recall is powerful, it is not the real reason we return to the drugs & alcohol.

When we have inner hurts and damaged emotions, because of what others have done to us or what we have done to other people, we have learned that

chemicals medicate our painful memories. For many that is the reason that they continue to drink and drug. We medicate our emotional pain.

Inner healing is a process. It is not an overnight cure for the problems of our flesh. There are many facets to inner healing. Every good thing God does for us helps us on our way to health and recovery. Inner healing is not a substitute for walking in faith. It is just one part of becoming whole and healthy in our relationships with God, ourselves and others.

There is a division of labor in the inner healing process. There is a part for which God is responsible, and there is a part for which we are responsible. We cannot do God’s part and God will not do our part.

As we go through this process, we have to take the time to go deeply into our inner man. We willingly give God access to the deep areas of our lives. That is the way God chooses to transform us and change us from “glory to glory”.

We do not simply use our imagination; we will actually bring the Lord Jesus Christ into each experience. We will allow Him to give us insight into the situation, and we will allow Him to heal us by giving Him complete freedom to touch and transform the broken places inside of us.

We will not forget the bad things that have happened. Memories will always be with

us. Everything we have experienced is either in our conscious or subconscious minds.

Our problem is that memories from the past influence us in the present. It is like we carry around an invisible bag of past hurts that weigh us down emotionally.

Unless they are healed, those things which have been fermenting over a long period of time will cause us to react in a certain way toward others. In spite of the old saying, time does **not** heal all wounds.

Any dominant memory that continues to surface and cause us shame, pain or anger is a sure sign that something is not right within us. These are the memories we bring before the Lord for healing and cleansing.

God does not erase the memories, but we will realize they have been healed when we remember the incident, but the hurt and pain no longer accompany the memory. Only then we can, ***“release those things which are behind and reach forward to what lies ahead, and press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.”*** (Philippians 3:14)

When men first come into the Inner Healing Class, they haven't laid hold of this scripture. Most of the men are



hopeless, fearful, and have no plan and no purpose. Over the ten-week course, God pursues their hearts and changes their belief systems. They come in wondering, "What is going to happen to me?", my

usual comment to them is that their lives will never be the same. They don't know how to take that comment, but as the healing begins, they start to realize that their old lives are dead and they are becoming new creations in Christ as mentioned in 2 Corinthians 5:17.

### **Chris George**



Since that time, God has greatly blessed D.M.C. with an expanded ministry and with new additions as needs have arisen. We give thanks and all glory to Jesus Christ our Lord for what He has done and look forward to what He wants to accomplish through our various ministries.

**CAMPFIRE**

The campfire is a monthly publication proclaiming what the Lord Jesus Christ can do, and has done, for men in bondage to alcohol and drugs. This publication does not represent any particular denomination, but seeks to encourage all believers "to keep the unity of the Spirit", (Eph. 4:3), not in the letter of the law, but in the spirit of meekness and love.
