"Live!"

There is a scripture in Ezekiel that reveals God's nature and His passion for us. He spoke through the prophet to the people of Jerusalem and He said to them, "Then I passed by and saw you kicking about in your blood, and as you lay there in your blood I said to you, 'Live!'" What a vivid and powerful statement. This happens again and again as the Lord finds His people in places of rebellion and 'death'. He is not content with leaving us there. I was blind and I could not see. I could not see my Lord, I could not see His love, I could not see his broken heart, I could not see His thorn-crowned head, and I saw no beauty in the gracious One. My eyes were covered in blindness as I flailed about trying to find my way. There is nothing more blind than the one whom is dead. Insensitivity overwhelmed me as I could not feel the presence, smell the fragrance, or taste the sweetness of God. I was not alive to God.

And then ... I was quickened. I was made alive. In the King James version, Ephesians 2:1 reads, "You hath He quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins." I began to live and the life-blood of Jesus began to flow through my veins. Everything seemed different to me; I looked at all things through new eyes, and heard with new ears; Christ was near me, His Spirit was within me. I began to hunger for the Bread of Life and thirst for the Living Water. I became a new creation. Hallelujah! He is risen!

The men on the back page are recent graduates who have experienced this new, abundant life for themselves. Paul describes this resurrection a few verses later in Ephesians 2:4-5:

"But because of His great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions – it is by grace you have been saved. And God raised us up with Christ..."
